PROJECT SUMMARY	The project aims to ensure sustainable balanced development of centralized drinking water supply, water discharge and sewage treatment in the village of Zbranki, Ovruch district of Zhytomyr region, to solve the lack of sanitation in the rural area, to meet the needs of consumers, especially people, in the water of guaranteed quality, to reduce the negative impact on the environment. Assistance in the implementation of the pilot infrastructure project on water and sanitation. Partial repair of water supply systems, partial reconstruction of treatment facilities, restoration of artesian well, replacement of equipment, channelling of households to existing water pipes.
